# CHAI MITZVAH \$1000 ISRAEL SCHOLARSHIP

Teens participating in the HPCT-CAE Shabbat Lunch and Learn program (Teen Aseret and/or Teen Musar) are eligible to receive \$1,000 towards a non-school, summer program in Israel that includes at least three (3) shabbats. Students whose trip is subsidized by Root One are eligible to receive \$500.

USY provides Jewish teens with transformative <u>travel experiences</u>, opening their eyes to new places, different ways of life, and some of the world's most spectacular sights. <u>Scholarships</u> are available.

#### ROOTONE

<u>RootOne</u> helps thousands of Jewish teens travel to Israel each through an ambitious initiative, seeded by a generous gift from The Marcus Foundation and powered by The Jewish Education Project.

To receive a \$3,000 RootOne voucher, a student must be a current 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> or 11<sup>th</sup> grader and NOT be attending an Orthodox Jewish Day School. The student must be planning to attend one of the programs many partners; those programs can be found on the <u>RoutOne website</u> and include Camp Ramah and Young Judea. The \$3,000 scholarship is sent directly to the summer program.

There is no deadline to apply; once the 7,000 available scholarships are distributed applicants will be placed on a waiting list.
